The solo violin works alternate partitas and sonatas. Partitas are simply suites of dances, although we shall quickly see that Bach's dances aren't meant for court or rustic dancers. The sonatas take the form of sonata di chiesa (church sonatas), old-fashioned by the time Bach got around to writing them - old-fashioned even in Vivaldi's day.
